## Summary:

Test Bed ED-X provides for the implementation of network infrastructure, using instances of software made freely available by the Gaia-X initiative (Digital Clearing House (DCH) and Cross Federation Service Components (XFSC)), as well as by the IDSA initiative (Data Space Protocol specification and Minimum Viable Data Space (MVDS)) among others (Fiware). All the co-promoters, with the exception of TICE.PT, will have the infrastructure to carry out 43 pilots by September 2025. The pilots will take advantage of the interconnection of data ecosystems, helping to strengthen digitalisation in the participating companies. This Test Bed is aligned with the objectives of the RRP and Component 16, 'Companies 4.0' for digital transformation and the transition to an increasingly secure, interconnected and transparent society.

## Objective(s):

This Test Bed will help SMEs and Startups to:

- Have access to state-of-the-art technological infrastructures from the largest national telecoms operators;
- Have close contact with directives, guidelines and developments at European level for the new data economy, getting closer to their international counterparts and promoting their association with European communities in this sector;
- Develop products and services quickly, thus increasing its competitiveness in the market.
